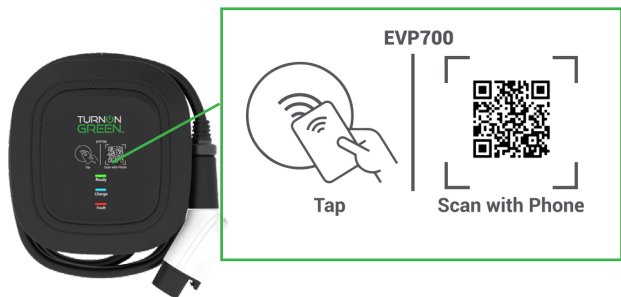


EV Charger Interface

How your guests access EV chargers

Hotel owners and staff members will need to be well versed in the details of EV charger activation. Below is a useful guide about how drivers will access the EV chargers on your property.



Charger ID and QR Code

TurnOnGreen EV chargers are labeled with an identification alpha numeric code, as well as a QR code for access.

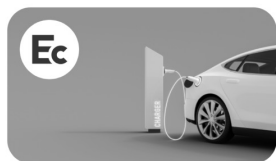
The guest will scan the QR code on the charger, and will be taken to a web page for activation - no app required.

Credit card and pre-authorization

Once the EV charger is plugged into the vehicle, guests will enter their credit card.

Typically, a \$15 pre-authorization allows the session to begin.

To conclude the charging session, the guest will unplug the vehicle. Any remaining balance from the pre-authorization will be refunded.
